To restore dignity and self-esteem – one person, one load of laundry and one neighborhood at a time.

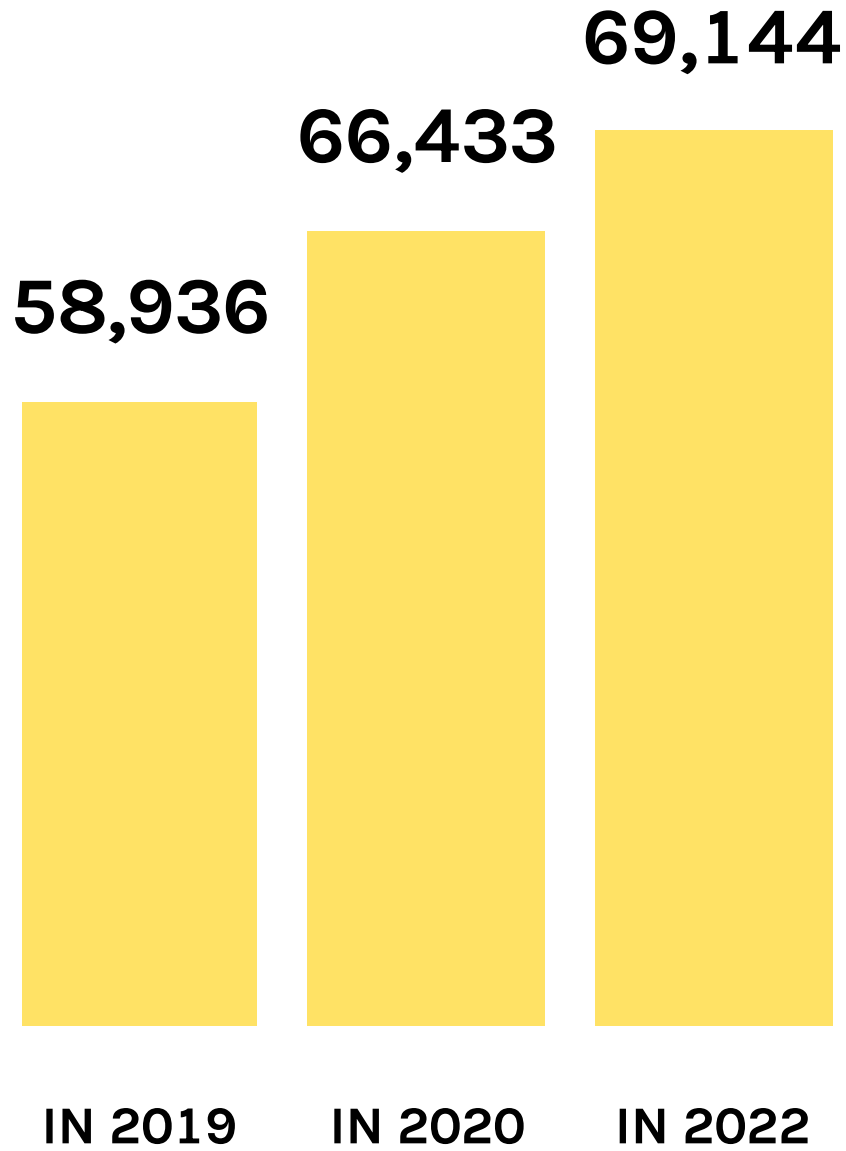


Created in 2017 by Jodie Dolan, The Laundry Truck LA is one of the first mobile laundry services in the country to serve people experiencing homelessness and our neighbors in need.

Wash. Dry. Fold. We believe these are the first three steps to impacting the dignity, mental health and hygiene of our local unhoused community.

With 250,000 lbs of laundry completed since 2019, TLTLA aims to improve day to day livelihood, enable employment opportunities and support school attendance.

# UNHOUSED POPULATION IN LA



The results of LAHSA's 2022 Homeless Count estimated that 69,144 people were experiencing homelessness in LA County at that time, a 4.1% rise from 2020, and 41,980 people were experiencing homelessness in the City of LA, up 1.7% from 2020. (A count was not conducted in 2021 due to the COVID pandemic.)\*

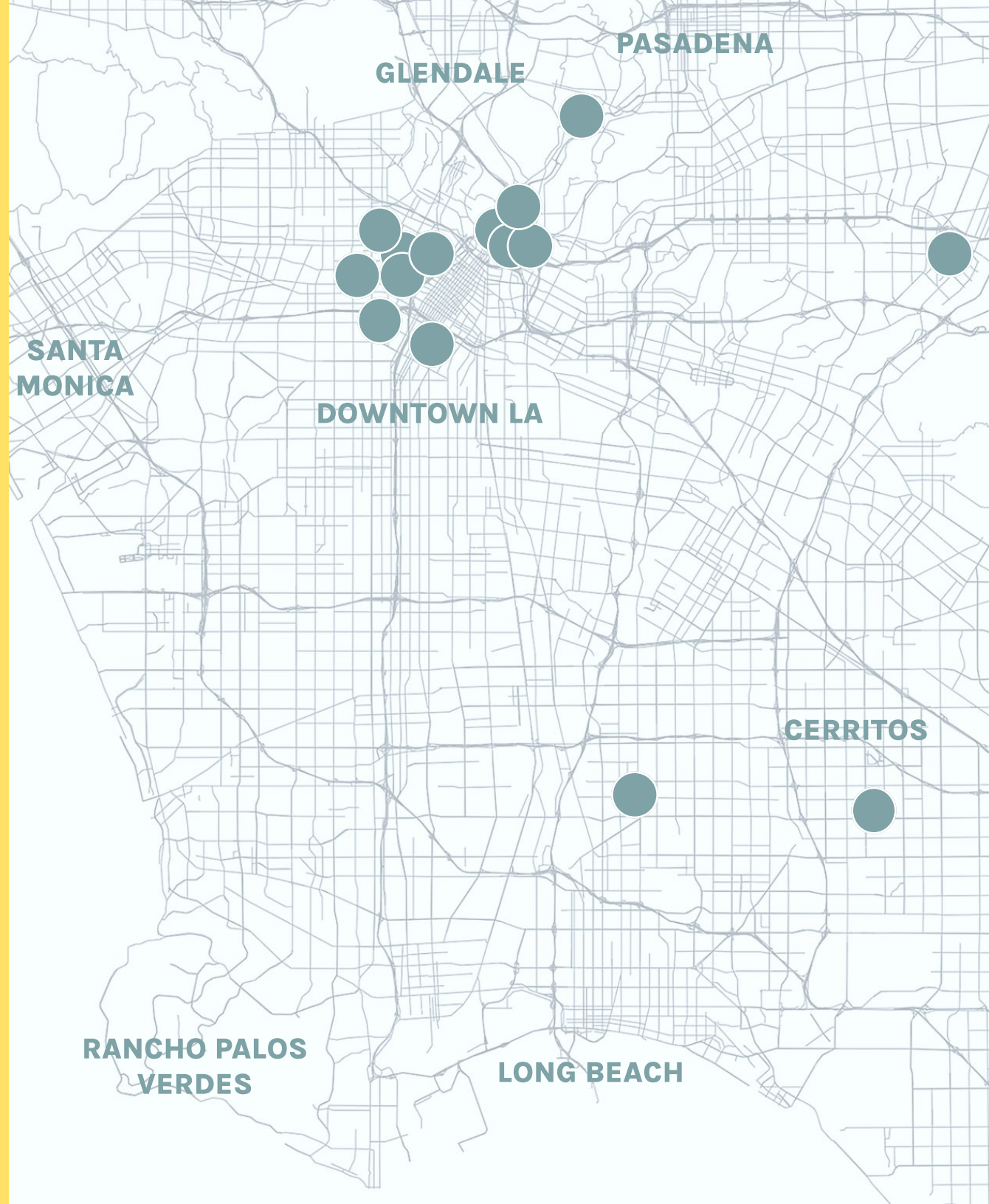


## WHERE WE SERVED OUR COMMUNITY THIS YEAR

## WHAT HAPPENS DURING A SERVICE DAY



- Each trailer is towed to the service location from our parking lot in Lincoln Heights or straight from the previous service location. A generator is also towed separately, if electricity is not available at the location.
- Once the trailer arrives, our attendant sets it up for service, by connecting the water, the sewer, and the electrical hoses.
- Our attendant starts collecting loads directly from guests (or the hosting location's staff) who sign our drop off form.
- We then wash, dry, and fold the clothes.
- The loads are placed in a new bag and passed back to the guests or to the staff who signs the form acknowledging that the loads have been picked up.
- At the end of the shift, the attendant cleans the trailer, collects the hoses, and gets everything ready for the trailer to be transported back to our parking lot or to the next service location.
